1. What This Policy Covers

This Cookie Policy explains how TPG Corporation LLC uses cookies and similar technologies on swapcoinvest.com and app.swapcoinvest.com.

2. What Cookies Are

Cookies are small text files or similar identifiers placed on a device or browser to recognize the device, store preferences, maintain sessions, support security, measure performance, or deliver analytics and marketing functions.

3. Categories of Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies support essential site operation such as page routing, authentication, account security, fraud prevention, and payment session continuity.

Preference cookies remember user choices such as language, region, display settings, and account convenience options.

Analytics cookies help measure traffic, user journeys, product interaction, conversion events, and service performance.

Advertising or targeting cookies may be used for audience measurement, retargeting, or campaign attribution where such technologies are actually used and lawfully configured.

4. Legal and Practical Approach

Strictly necessary technologies may be used where they are genuinely required for a requested service or for the secure operation of the Platform.

Non-essential cookies and similar technologies should only be set after the user receives clear information and, where required by law, gives valid consent through an affirmative action.

5. How Users Can Control Cookies

Users may manage preferences through the Platform's cookie banner, cookie settings panel, browser settings, or device-level controls, subject to the limits of available technology.

Disabling some cookies may reduce functionality, affect login persistence, interrupt certain workflows, or limit access to analytics-based product improvements.

6. Third-Party Technologies

The Platform may rely on third-party providers for hosting, analytics, anti-fraud controls, content delivery, embedded media, communication tools, or advertising integrations. Where those tools place cookies or similar identifiers, the Company should identify them in the website's live cookie table or preference center.
